Warm-up Procedure - Warm-ups for the first match of the day for each team is 4-4-2 (mins). All subsequent matches are 3-3. No shared hitting. All ties will be broken in accordance to the rules as stated in the KRVA Operating Code.

Play-offs - The top two teams in each pool will advance to play-offs. The 1st and 2nd place records get a bye and work the quarters. The losers of the quarters work the semis. Quarters are one game to 25 no cap. Losers of the semis, closest to CALVARY must work the final. Semi-finals and Finals will be the best of 3 games with no cap. The first two games will be 25 pts and the third if needed will be 15 pts. The bottom two teams will have one play off game to 25 to decide who makes it into the silver bracket.

We will have a "Silver Bracket Playoff" with the remaining teams using the same format as used for the "Gold Bracket"

All teams must abide by the following rules:

- 1 ***No smoking on the church property!!!***
- 2 No food, drink, or gum in the gym except for players who may have fluids during their match play.
- 3 Teams may have sport drinks and water on the matted area while playing but are asked to clean up the bench area when finished playing. Drinks will be cleared after each match. No one else in the gym is permitted with drinks.
- 4 Players may eat in their campout area but need to clean up before the team may leave.
- 5 Teams may not bring any electrical appliances or tables for food and drink in your campout area at the tournament.
- 6 Spectators may only use chairs with rubber tips on the bottom.
- 7 Teams are assigned a campout area and sleeping bags are permitted.
- 8 You may not use balls in the hallways. Warm-up in the gym only.
- 9 Any player or parent not complying with these rules will result in a warning to the team. The second warning will result in disqualification of the team and all remaining games will be forfeited.
- 10 Coaches should be sure players and parents are aware of these rules. Thank you for your cooperation and participation in our tournament.
